







The United States Post Office (USPS) has produced a special Old Home Day cancellation available at the Franconia Post Office and the Franconia Welcome Center for canceling mail posted on July 8th





ADDED ATTRACTIONS

FRANCONIA AREA HERITAGE MUSEUM is an 1878 farmhouse with attached barns and sheds that reflect life in Franconia since the town's settlement. It is open to the public 1-4 p.m. on Saturdays from Memorial Day through Columbus Day. The Museum is free of charge to our visitors with donations always appreciated. Volunteers are available to answer questions. "**Recipes to Remember**" a cookbook of local family and historical recipes is available for sale at the museum and the Franconia Welcome Center.

FRANCONIA ARTWALK self-guided tour of over thirty sculptures located throughout the village with maps located at the Iron Furnace, Franconia Market parking lot, and Franconia's Welcome Center. **www.franconiaartwalk.org**

HOMECOMING PARADE

The theme for the 2023 Old Home Day 250th Anniversary Parade is "FRANCONIA – Yesterday, Today, & Tomorrow celebrating Franconia's historic past, it's dynamic present, and the possibilities for the future.

The Grand Marshall for the parade is Mrs. Kay Whitcomb of Easton. Kay was born in Easton in 1935 at the family home the Cooley Farm (which is still in existence). She started school in a one room schoolhouse with no running water, heated by a wood stove, and only limited electricity. Later in Kay's life, she entered classes in Sugar Hill school (later to become the Carolina Crapo Memorial).

Kay attended Dow Academy where she graduated 1953. Kay states, "We had a great education. There were not many children and we had excellent teachers."

After Kay went to business school, she returned and worked as a bookkeeper for various hotels and businesses.

She married George Whitcomb and raised three wonderful children. Kay and George met in first grade. They never really "dated". "There were so few of us that you just knew everyone." said Kay.

Even with a family Kay always had to be "doing something"; selling Tupperware and Avon or working in the town office for 32 years. When asked what her duties were, Kay replied, "Just about everything. If it needed to be done I did it."

Kay became a member of the board of directors for the Franconia Area Heritage Council where she is still an active board member today.

One of Kay's responses to the commonly asked question, "Have you lived here all your life?" is her witty response "Not yet!"

When asked what she loves most about living in the valley, she replies, "I love looking at the mountains even when they are dark and angry because I know they will soon change."

Many thanks Kay for sharing a rich history of our area and for all she has done and all she continues to do for our town. Her positive attitude is truly a gift.

The parade will begin at approximately 1PM beginning from the Dow Avenue Extension, along Main Street past Town Hall, concluding at the Lafayette Elementary School.


